perish:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ to die▪ to be destroyed	
dismay:	sudden helpless fear of what is about to happen or what has happened	
summon:	to order to come	
shudder:	to tremble with horror, fear, cold, etc.	
incantation:	a set of words spoken to cast a magic spell	
shrill:	describes a sound that is high and sharp	
vile:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ very bad▪ foul or disgusting	
prodigious:	very large in size, amount, or degree
